Jean Hayes Award

A True Champion - Jean Hayes Distinguished Service Award
75 years membership with DOGS NSW

The Royal NSW Canine Council trading as DOGS NSW would like to recognise Jean Hayes today, in recognition of her dedicated service as a founding member of the Bulli & District Kennel Club and work with numerous Dogs Shows in the Illawarra & South East Region. In addition we would also like to honour her with a memento of her amazing 75 years continuous membership with DOGS NSW.



Congratulations Jean on such an outstanding achievement! Some further information about Jean's achievement in the dog world... In recent years The Royal Agricultural Show have introduced awards to recognise outstanding exhibitors. In 2015 Jean Hayes was chosen as the CHAMPION of the Domestic Animals Section for her long standing and successful exhibiting at the Royal. She was also awarded a 35 year service medal (although she has exhibited continuously for 64 years!) which was presented before the General Specials.

The Flood family started showing in 1945. Mainly in the local shows in Wollongong. Jean entered the ring the first time in 1948. The Flood family didn't just show. They were also founding members of Bulli and District Kennel Club and worked for many of the Dog Shows in the Illawarra and South East Region..

Jean's first Scottish Terrier was Terry, Montrose Marble bred by Jack Maude. In 1951 she entered three Scottish terriers in the Royal. Scotia Serenity, Scotia Shannon Rose and Scotia So Cute. These bitches were placed 2nd, 3rd and 4th. About 50 Scotties were shown.1955 was the start of winning at the Royal when Jean was awarded Reserve Challenge Bitch with Ch. Scotia Socialite.

The Flood sisters Kath, Molly and Jean earned a reputation for showing solid Scotties which were well prepared and won. Unfortunately Jean is the last surviving member of the Flood family.

In 1982 Jean won Best in Group at the Royal with Ch. Mayson Troubadour (Imp U.K.). That year she also won Challenge Bitch with Scotia Slightly Vane. Over the years Jean has won the Strathbogie Trophy at the Royal a record three times in 1976, 1986 and 1987. The Strathbogie Trophy is not awarded every year. It rewards kennels who are significant in the breed. To be awarded your kennel needs to win a challenge, another first place and a second place at the Royal.

In more recent time at the Royal Ch. Scotia Swansong won bitch challenge in 2004, 2007 and 2008 and Jean won RUBOB in 2013 with Ch. Robscott Lady Nina and Reserve Challenge Bitch in 2015 with Ch. Robscott Sand Mist.

Jean continues to be a real competitor and is still actively showing. Jean says the Scotties keep her young.
