In praise of those who rescue and care for Scotties

The picture above is of Jock. He was re-homed with another two Scotties from the same place in Victoria. Jock has wonderful new owners in Victoria and he lives with their other dogs and his new owners who travel between their farm and town house with the dogs in tow in the course of their business

The other male Scottie now lives with a lady in South Yarra and shares drinks on the terrace each evening with her friends and visits his new beach house whenever his owner goes down there

I had enormous help from Nicholas Lynn who lives in Melbourne and who took the boys in and fostered them till I was able to find their forever homes
Thank you Nicholas

The other Scottie is female and she came with bladder cancer and was about to be taken to a shelter and of course put down

I persuaded the owner to let me try and find her a foster carer and the wonderful Lyn Campbell of Mudgee and her partner Peter said definitely send her to us.

Well Peter picked her up in Melbourne and she was taken to Lyn and Peter's Scottie retreat where she was accepted by all the other Scotties Lyn and Peter own

This is the fifth Scottie Lyn has taken in connection with me and she also has collected others along the way As they live on a small holding with other animals and are free to roam what could be better
Lyn has just been awarded a trophy from this Club for her services to Scotties and their rescue..... very appropriately in my opinion

The Scottie by the way is still doing well even with the cancer and we have her on Coriolus/Grifola for cancer along with the vet's medication, and they can't believe how well she is doing
Of course as soon as she is suffering Lyn will have to let her go

Now if you think any of this sounds easy let me tell you it took weeks for all of us to arrange and come to this happy ending

Money from the Rescue Fund had to be used, and now I am in the throes of rescuing two female Scotties from RSPCA Yagoona, the fund will have to pay for the vet fees needed to get the girls to re-homing fitness

They were seized from a Puppy Farm along with Westies, King Charles, Labs and Retrievers plus other pure breeds

I pick them up this week and once they are re-homed (one already has a new owner to go to) I will right more with photos

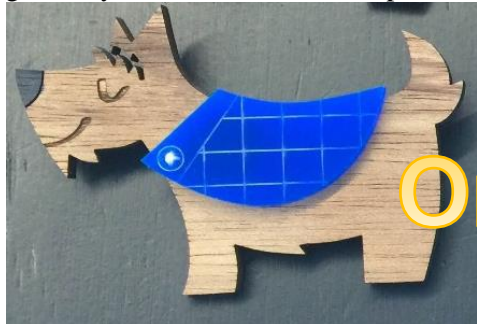
