The STC Inc. Easter Championship Show Critique

Judge Mrs Alison Kenny - Marriot (UK)

It was a great pleasure to judge this special show. Thanks to the hardworking officers and committee for inviting me

and also extending such wonderful hospitality to my husband and myself during our stay in Sydney. It will stay in our memories for a long time.

The weather was kind and the show ran impeccably thanks David, the steward and Jo and Marion. They considered the dogs comfort all the time and no dogs were left in the sun for any period of time. Thanks to all the sporting exhibitors who accepted my placings with good grace and gave me such a numerically excellent entry to judge.

My principal winners were –

Best in Show Donahue's CH MACPRAIN MEMORY LANE Best Opposite Sex Goldsworthy's CH STUANE ROYAL MYTH Best Puppy Campbell's BESCOTT CELTIC MYTH

All my principal winners displayed excellent breed type, were well presented and a credit to their owners.

My main observations about the breed from the entry that I judged were as follows.

Most exhibits displayed good bone and substance and expression and

stops were very good on the whole. However, there were a few poor mouths and fronts and some lacking in ribs.

Some exhibits were much too high off the ground caused by poor angulation and also some were well up to size especially in bitches. Some exhibits could have got higher placings if the coat presentation was better.

You do have enthusiastic breeders/exhibitors /owners that love the breed and are keeping the Scottie flag flying and you should all be commended for that.

I know it cannot be easy for Australians to import dogs these days. Not many foreign breeders are willing to keep a puppy to import to you, as they have to keep a puppy for such a long period of time. Your gene pool is not extensive and this is becoming a problem even in the UK.

You do have some dogs that could make a difference to your breeding programme but you should bear in mind what your dog needs to improve and try and line breed to a dog that is correct breed type and quality.

Thank you again for you inviting me to judge this wonderful breed that we all love so much. I wish you all good luck and happy breeding in the future.
